



New Recycling Options for Renfrew Blue Box Program 2010

Stream 1: Fibre

The Blue Box Recycling Program is being enhanced through the additional pick up of fibre materials. Now when you take your recyclable to the curb side you will no longer have to tie and bundle up your cardboard/boxboard. Newspaper, writing paper and computer paper will no longer have to be placed in separate bags and tied shut. Place all of the following products in a blue box or in your largest cardboard box and place at the curb side for removal.

Fibre:



- Newsprint
- Boxboard and paperboard
- Magazines and telephone directories
- Envelopes, flyers, junk mail
- Fine paper including writing and computer paper
- Brown paper bags
- Plain wrapping paper and tissue paper (not including Christmas paper or wrapping paper with a printed pattern on it)
- Greeting cards
- Paper cups and plates
- Polycoat paperboard
- Corrugated cardboard



Do not mix your fibre material waste with your other regular blue box waste! The fibre waste will be picked up by a side/rear load compactor truck. This new fibre waste curb side removal schedule is the same as the blue box removal schedule.

Do not mix your regular blue box waste with you fibre material waste. The regular blue box waste will be picked up by the usual recycling truck. The regular blue box waste is to be placed at the curb side for removal as per the normal blue box schedule.



Stream 2: All Other

The regular curbside Blue Box Recycling Program has also been enhanced. The following is a list of items that can now be placed at the curbside for recycling.



Metals:

- Aluminum food and beverage containers
- Steel food and beverage containers
- Aluminum foil and foil containers
- EMPTY, dry paint cans with lids removed
- EMPTY aerosol cans (such as deodorant hairspray and spray paint) all types

Plastics:

- Plastics number 1-7
- Plastic tubs and lids
- Plastic Film (including grocery bags, bread bags)
- Polystyrene (including Styrofoam packaging for TV, stereos & electronic equipment; packaging pellets; cups; plastic knives, forks, spoons; meat trays; serving containers; bakery trays and covers; bubble wrap; flower pots)



Cartons:

- Milk and juice cartons
- Tetra packs (including drinking boxes)



Clear/Coloured Glass:

- Glass bottles and jars for food or beverage

ALL FOOD CONTAINERS MUST BE RINSED!
