The site is open to accept the WEEE from
Tuesday to Saturday
8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

This is a pilot program that will be in place for an
eight week period commencing

February 8th and finishing up on April 3rd 2010.

- This program is available free of charge to the residents of the Town of Renfrew.
- The Town of Renfrew residents are encouraged to bring the following WEEE waste for recycling.
- Desk top and laptop computers, peripherals such as keyboards, computer mouse, monitors, desktop printers, disk drives, fax machines and televisions, phones (landline and cellular), VCR and DVD players, stereos, PDAs, cameras and photocopiers.

Note: Only the above referenced items will be accepted for this WEEE Program.

All WEEE accepted at the landfill site, is to be carefully placed, as directed by the Landfill site manager, into the roll off box that is located right beside the weight scale.
